Consumer Reports, July 2021 issue tested and rated the following sunscreens and insect repellents. Here are their top picks after testing (water resistant, broad spectrum, doesn't contain chemicals, "natural" or "mineral" on label):

Sunscreens:

Hawaiian Tropic Island Sport Spray SPF 30 (\$9), overall score 75

Alba Botanica Hawaiian Coconut Clear Spray SPF 50 (\$11), overall score 72

Equate (Walmart) Sport Lotion SPF 50 (\$4), overall score 68

Insect Repellents:

Ben's Tick & Insect Repellent Wipes (\$6), overall score 96

Repel Lemon Eucalyptus Insect Repellent2 Pump (\$5), overall score 90

Sawyer Premium Insect Repellent Pump (\$9), overall score 83

SNACK SMARTER

Good Housekeeping, July/August issue pored over the nutrition facts, ingredient lists, and flavor of snacks and drinks. Here is their list of award winning healthy fruit finds:

COSMIC CRISP, apples, found at your local grocery store, a cross between Honeycrisp and Enterprise, the Cosmic Crisp is the perfect tart & sweet apple.

SOLELY ORGANIC, whole fruit gummies, found at whole food markets, bite size organic whole fruit checks made with fruit and vitamin C-that's it.

SIMPLE KITCHEN, freeze dried fruit, found at readywise.com, a unique drying method removes water without the need for additives or preservatives.

BARE, baked crunchy medley, found on amazon.com, made with real apples and strawberries, free of sugars, the chips are baked and crunchy.

NATURE'S GARDEN, probiotic apricots, found at naturesgarden.net, Turkish apricots dried to promote an improved digestive well-being and restore the balance of healthy gut bacteria.

HYDROGEN PEROXIDE (HP) USES IN THE GARDEN

Fresh cut flowers: adding a small amount of 3% hydrogen peroxide to water for fresh cut flowers helps kill bacteria and keeps flowers looking good longer. Change water daily and add HP.

House and garden plant stimulator: Mix 1 quart water and 2 Tablespoons 3% hydrogen peroxide in a spray bottle. Apply a light mist to plants.

Fungus control for roses and vegetables: To control fungus and mildew, mix 5 tablespoons baking soda and 5 tablespoons 3% hydrogen peroxide in on gallon of water. Apply.
