FOOD TRUCKS IN WIND MEADOWS

Per the Village of Wind Point Administrator: The Wind Meadows Leisure Center's zoning is Park and Conservancy District PC-1, which may not allow food trucks. Under the PC-1, permitted uses include public and existing private recreational uses, walking areas, picnic areas, play areas, open spaces and conservancy areas. Conditional uses include the extension of any existing, or creation of any new public or private recreation uses, or any recreational building or structure. Since a food truck, is considered a commercial use it would not be allowed, as it is neither listed as a permitted or conditional use in the zoning district.

Could a food truck operate in a residential neighborhood? It is not entirely clear. Wind Meadows is zoned R-3 Single Family and R-4 Multi-Family, and neither of the two districts have a permitted or conditional uses that allow for a business to operate. However, similar to the Leisure Center, the zoning code really only contemplates permanent uses on properties not a mobile vehicle that's parked only for a short period of time. The code does have parking regulations for commercial vehicle and also allows for the Village to prohibit parking on streets if traffic volume and safety are concerns.

Food trucks could also be considered transient merchants, which are regulated under the code (although not prohibited).

I don't believe that food trucks would be simply permitted outright and I don't believe that residents would simply just be able to have a food truck parked outside their home.

If residents would like to request to bring a food truck into the Village, given that there are no current regulations for them and that the zoning code is not clear on if they would be permitted or not, the most clear way to determine their status would be to have a food truck request reviewed by the Plan Commission. They could then make a decision on if the use would be permitted or not. Given that a food truck is a commercial use and is somewhat incompatible with the residential uses, I don't think that either the Plan Commission or Village Board would allow it, but it would be ultimately up to them.
